# CSU POLICE DEPARTMENTS

- Established in 1975 as a result of a 20% increase in crime on CSU campuses (45 years).
- CSU Northridge Police Departments as the 1<sup>st</sup> department in pilot program (1974).
- 23 Individual Campuses with their own PDs/Chiefs.
- 2 of 23 are under SAEM, the rest Administration
   & Finance.
- San Francisco State Police Department has been in SF State University since 1977 (43 years).

### MISSION STATEMENT

• The San Francisco State University Police Department is a diverse organization that prides itself with delivering professional community policing with integrity and sensitivity.

### BUDGET

- 4.2M annual (2020-2021)
- 45 (actual) DCS employees (Ft/Pt)
- 86% (\$3.6M) Personnel Funding (salaries, mandated trainings, overtime, shift differential and stipend pay) – decreased by \$775K due to positions being frozen.
- 14% (\$600K) Operations/Equipment Funding






